Unconfirmed Species: The 7 species listed below have been reported only once in Umatilla County. There are no identifiable photographs, video recordings or sound recordings, which document their occurrence in the county: Brant, Brown Pelican, Red Knot, Long-tailed Jaeger, Yellow-b. Sapsucker, Hutton's Vireo, Blackpoll Warbler.

Species No Longer Present: Greater Sage-Grouse, extirpated; Sharp-tailed Grouse, extirpated; Northern Bobwhite, introduced but no viable population.
